They can begin accumulating scholarship points in 8th grade. They then apply to scholarship senior year and every senior can get a scholarship. - d) Committee Reports- Fort Bend County Fair Concession Stand- highest grossing fundraiser. We netted around \$20,000 last year. Sept. 26th- soft opening through Oct. 6th. auctions. It's The Pits Cookers-Help students that didn't do well at fair. 3 students were picked and got \$1200 each from the organization. Chapter is in the middle of their Vertical Raise Fundraiser. Last year they raised \$18,000 with this. This fundraiser helps to pay for buses, contest registrations, etc... Runs through Wednesday the 29<sup>th</sup>. LDE season is starting. Posted in FFA Canvas Pages. Please get your kids to sign up. November 18<sup>th</sup> meeting will be a Thanksgiving Potluck.
