- c) Committee Reports- Points Committee- Tiffany Loos- 50% of what we raise goes to chapter/ 50% goes to senior scholarships. Last year we had over \$13,000 scholarship/ \$13,000 chapter. They can begin accumulating scholarship points in 8th grade. They then apply to scholarship senior year and every senior can get a scholarship. If you ever want to know how many points your child has, you can ask the scholarship committee.
- d) Committee Reports- Fort Bend County Fair Concession Stand- highest grossing fundraiser. We netted around \$20,000 last year. Sept. 26th- soft opening through Oct. 6th.
